



## ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE POLICY

The Selectboard of the Town of Killington, County of Rutland, State of Vermont, hereby adopts the following policy:

### Definitions:

- 1) "All Terrain Vehicles" or "ATV" means any non-highway recreational vehicle, except snowmobiles, when used for cross-country travel on trails or on any one of the following or a combination thereof, land, water, snow, ice, marsh, swampland and natural terrain. An "All-Terrain Vehicle" or "ATV" on a highway shall be considered a motor vehicle.

### A.

All class 2 and class 3 & 4 Killington Town Highways are **CLOSED** to ATV travel with the following exceptions:

#### LITTLE SHERBURNE ROAD TH#23

All of Little Sherburne road is open.

#### RICHARDSON ROAD TH#22

All of Richardson Road is open.

#### STEVEN'S ROAD TH#21

All of Stevens Road is open.

#### OXBOW ROAD #19

All of Oxbow Road is open.


### B.

This policy shall terminate one (1) year from the date hereof unless sooner replaced by the adoption by the Town of Killington of an ordinance for the regulation of ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES pursuant to 24 V.S.A. Chapter 59.
