RECREATION DIRECTOR UPDATE:

Summer Concerts: Kim has completed the entire lineup for the River Road Free Summer Concert Series. This concert series is co-sponsored by the Parks & Recreation, Sherburne Memorial Library and the Sherburne Friends of the Library. The concerts, held at the library on Thursday evenings at 6:30 pm, begin on July 7th and continue through August 18th. The complete lineup can be found as an addendum to the minutes. Please note that some groups are new to the series.

Date Night remains popular and we will continue to provide sessions as long as there are requests.

On April 8th & 9th and April 15th & 16th, Kim will participate in Lifeguard Instructor

Certification. The cost is \$750 plus expenses since this course is offered in New Hampshire. After completion, Kim will be certified to hold training sessions for our lifeguards and perhaps others from surrounding towns for a fee.

Scholarships for summer camps will be available again this year. There will be a more detailed application form with a sliding income scale. The Rotary, Sherburne Women's Club and the Killington Elementary School contribute to the scholarships.

OLD BUSINESS:

As of today there are two sign ups for summer camp. The brochure is complete and has been distributed. The collaboration with Killington Resort is on track and the contract will probably be signed this week. Yellow Bus will provide transportation.

NEW BUSINESS:

There will be a Babysitting Class on April 23rd and 24th at the Rutland Regional Medical Center. The cost is \$60. This course is designed for young adults between the ages of ten and thirteen and is a fairly serious curriculum.

Since the Killington Seniors have been so successful in the Red Dot program, Gerrie asked if the Recreation Department could reward the group by possibly taking them out to lunch. The commission agreed and details will be worked out by Kim and Gerrie at a later date.
