

**TOWN OF KILLINGTON ZONING BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT**  
**Meeting of August 25, 2010**

Ron Riquier, Chair opened the meeting at 5:04 p.m.

**1. Approval of Agenda**

Motion by Lou Grob to approve the agenda, Jay Hickory seconded. 3 in favor. (Marty Post joined the meeting after this vote.)

**2. Approval of Minutes**

Motion by Lou Grob to review the document presented by Charlie Holland listing items he requested be added to the minutes of August 5, 2010. Motion failed due to lack of a second.

Ron Riquier suggested taking each item on the submitted document one at a time. Item #1 “Cavanaugh: Talks about a vendetta.” After some discussion, the Board could not recall that such a statement had been made. Motion by Lou Grob to strike Item #1, Marty Post seconded. All in favor.

Looking at the remaining items, the Board entered into a lengthy discussion as to whether any of the items listed actually had any bearing on the minutes of August 5<sup>th</sup> and whether Mr. Holland had the ability to make changes to the Board’s minutes.

Motion by Jay Hickory to accept the Minutes of August 5, 2010 as written, Lou Grob seconded. Discussion. Ron Riquier noted that Mr. Holland does not have the ability to make additions or corrections to the minutes. Only the Board can do this. Vote on motion as stated. All in favor.

**3. Findings of Fact on Application 10-030**

Motion by Marty Post to accept the Findings of Fact on the Charlie Holland Appeal as presented, Lou Grob seconded. All in favor.

**4. Findings of Fact on Application 10-031**

Motion by Marty Post to accept the Findings of Fact on the George Cone Appeal as presented, Lou Grob seconded. All in favor.

The Findings of Fact on Applications 10-030 and 10-031 were distributed for signature.

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**5. Other Business**

The Board discussed the correspondence submitted by Charlie Holland.

Motion by Marty Post to add the document presented by Charlie Holland to the Minutes of August 25, 2010 with a statement that the information contained in this document was presented but insufficient to incorporate in the minutes of the previous meeting. Motion failed due to lack of a second.

After further discussion, the consensus was to acknowledge receipt of this document from Mr. Holland which will be filed as part of the public record.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:40 p.m.
