1. Call to Order

CH Finneron called the Meeting to order at 11:35 am.

2. Approval of the Agenda

A motion to approve the Agenda as presented, UNANIMOUS.

3. Selectboard Member Concerns

There were no Selectboard Member Concerns.

4. COVID-19 Special Procedures

TM Hagenbarth shared the Town would be posting a notice with general information and special procedures relating to the Corona Virus. [Notice from the Selectboard](#), attached.

A general statement would be placed on doors at the Town Offices to reiterate procedures and employees would also receive an in-house policy that should be strictly followed.

Andy Salamon had asked to remind residents limited supplies were available at the “Killington Food Cupboard” donated by the community and Congregation of the Sherburne United Church of Christ.

5. PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE – PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO KILLINGTON ZONING BYLAWS: DEFINITIONS, SECTION 407 – SHORT-TERM RENTAL OF DWELLING UNIT

It was agreed that the Selectboard Meeting of March 17, 2020 be canceled and the Public Hearing for proposed amendments to Killington Zoning By-Laws, short-term rental of dwelling unit; be postponed.

A motion to warn a Public Hearing on **Tuesday, April 21st, 2020** at 6:30 pm, convened by the Killington Selectboard at the Sherburne Memorial Library on the “Proposed Amendments to Killington Zoning By-Laws – Definitions and Section 407, Short-Term Rental of Dwelling Unit” was approved, UNANIMOUS.

Clarification was requested and TM Hagenbarth would follow up on the definition of “family occupied” in the Killington Zoning By-Laws, Accessory Dwelling Unit.

6. Other Business

There was discussion and concern regarding the Sherburne Memorial Library, a public meeting place, remaining open.

A motion that the Selectboard recommend and support the Library Board convene and consider closing through April 6th, 2020 in line with school closures was approved, UNANIMOUS.

The Solid Waste Transfer Station would maintain current posted hours.

The Highway Department would maintain their schedule accommodating the Employee Covid-19 Policy Procedures.

There was discussion regarding using an online *go-to-meeting* kind of software to enable Public Meetings to continue should there be no change in public meeting restrictions. TM Hagenbarth would research appropriate operating systems and guidelines for their use.
