**1. Call to Order**

Moderator Buhler introduced State Representative Jim Harrison who gave his [Legislative Report](#) and Librarian Jane Ramos also gave a short address. CH Finneron called the Meeting to order at 7:12 pm.

**2. Approval of the Agenda**
