Project Update – Killington Access Road Phase 1B

Date: 7/22/2024

Work for the week of 7/22/2024

We made it through the first weekend of the road being open. Continue to use caution if using the Access Road. Construction vehicle's will be entering and exiting the road and it will remain unpaved for a few more weeks. Be prepared for sudden stops and waiting on equipment to move around as we will continue to work behind the barrels that mark the edge of the travel way.

This week we will work to install the remaining water line. Once completed, we will pick back up on installing the sewer line on the east side of the road. This work will continue throughout the week.

Expect final sand and gravels to be installed along the west side of the project. Once final gravels are installed this week, we will shift traffic as far west as possible to make room for equipment along the east side.

This week we will also be working to shape the slope along the west side. By the end of the week, we hope most of the topsoil is installed and ready for seeding. Please be cautious as trucks with topsoil back off the road, stopping traffic while doing so.

We plan to work Saturday installing more topsoil and performing cleanup work.

Work for the week of 7/29/2024

Work for the following week will wrap up the sewer line installation. We are awaiting word on when utility lines are to be transferred to the new power poles, but in the meantime, we will spend part of this week shaping up the east slopes as much as possible.

We will plan to wrap up any remaining topsoiling on the west side this week, followed by installing a drainage pipe in the ditch line along the west side as well.

There will be some grading work near the "Welcome to Killington" sign. Once completed, we plan to have a landscaping company onsite to start planning out and installing some of the trees, shrubs, etc. in that area along with the western slope. Expect additional landscaping equipment on the road as plants are trucked around to their final position.

Saturday work will be more clean up, topsoiling, seeding and mulching this weekend
